## **About HOA**

HOA is a non-profit financial corporation dedicated to making home ownership possible for low and moderate-income families through the provision of alternative mortgages. HOA also provides loan guarantees to proponents for the development and construction of affordable housing, primarily in southern Ontario.

## **HOA Board**

In 2019, the HOA Board will be comprised of 14 Directors who are accountable for effective governance of HOA’s operations, and for fulfilling its legal role and responsibilities under its Bylaws and applicable legislation and regulations.

## **Required Competencies and Experience**

We welcome qualified candidates who have the financial, governance and risk expertise appropriate for the prudent oversight of our organization and to ensure the current and strategic needs of the organization are met.

We are currently looking to welcome individuals who have the following professional expertise:

- Construction (Development, Financing or Project Management)
- Government/Public Sector Relations
- Marketing/Public Relations
- Member Relations
- Real Estate Industry (Agent/Broker)

In addition to having the appropriate skills, expertise and competencies, the ideal candidates will:

- be able to voice individual opinions and logical reasoning to support well-informed board decision making
- previous experience on Non-Profit Boards or committees is an asset.

**Commitment:**

- Directors are elected for a 3-year term
- Attend bi-monthly Board meetings usually held in the evenings (September – June)
- Contribute as a member on a Board Committee
- Attend HOA's AGM in June each year

The deadline for receipt of submissions is April 30, 2019.

Elections will take place at the AGM to be held in Toronto on June 19, 2019.
